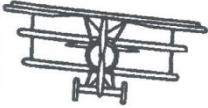

One such maneuver is the Lomcevak. Lomcevak is the Czech word for hangover or headache. It originates from aerobatics pilot Ladislav Bezak mechanic. It is a violent tumbling maneuver done by raising the nose and then applying full left aileron and rudder and full down elevator. About 2 or 3 tumbles are the norm but in models it can be extended with a greater power to weight ratio. It is known for high headache causing G's in aerobatic comp.

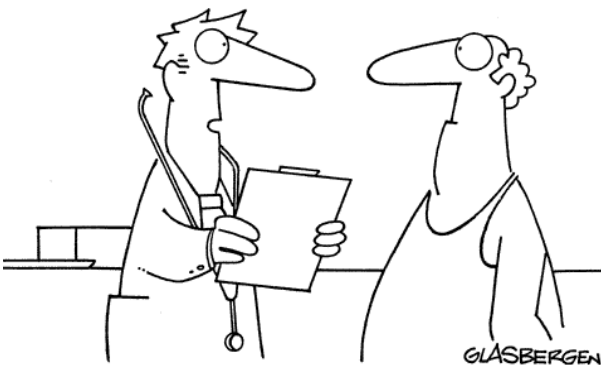

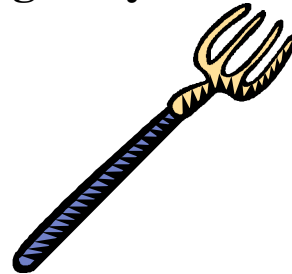

One Tip

Sometimes new props have a tight enough fit on the engine shaft that they need to be wound on. This is okay until you get to the hub and the engine turns over. At the same time, getting the prop off can be a problem with the engine turning over rather than the prop winding off. To overcome the engine turning, place two prop nuts on the shaft and tighten them against each other so they don't move. Then by holding one nut, the prop can be turned on or off the shaft without damaging anything. Remove the two nuts and continue to spin the prop off easily
