

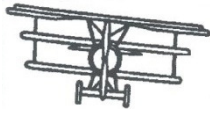

Stay on Georgia Ave. all the way to the end. Drive across the railroad tracks at the Light Rail Station. Our flying field is on top of the hill, just off to the right.
