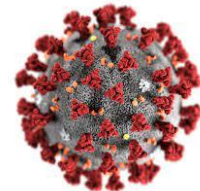


Riemer Field 18 Wildon Court Kingsville

We are still welcome to use Riemer Field. Judge your ability to fly something safely. Never fly alone. Small to mid size electric planes are more suitable for this venue. 40 size nitro have not fared well here yet. Consider, there is the disaster just waiting to happen when a nitro plane goes down into the home owner's or neighbors' houses.

If you go to Riemer Field. Go through the gate, bear left down the stone road. Then veer more to the left and drive with high grass just to the left of your vehicle. Follow to runway. DO NOT DRIVE ACROSS THE RUNWAY. Turn right and follow along runway to the end and turn left to other side of runway. Set up on far side facing the house.

Covid 19 – I'm completely vaccinated but have to be extremely careful as I am in touch with an "at risk" family member too young to get shots.
